INFO YOU NEED TO KEEP YOUR DOG (or other pet) HAPPY

HAH Dog Tags

All pet dogs in HAH must have a dog tag. The form to request a tag can be found on the HAH website under the Members Information tab/forms. The dog tag should be available to be picked up at Security one week after submitting the form. Be sure to use a good phone number on the tag so that it is easy to reach you. Security is required to pick up any loose dogs. When security picks up a dog, they will call the owner if the dog has a tag. If there is no tag, security will hold the dog at the maintenance area and then they call HAH member Sherrill Hunt. She has a microchip scanner and works with local dog rescues. If the dog has a chip, she will contact the owner. If no chip is found, she will hold the dog for 3 days. After 3 days, she will take the dog to one of the local dog rescue centers. If the dog is abandoned, it will be taken to a dog rescue as well.

Walking Your Dog

Inside of HAH

There are three good open areas to walk your dog – Area 54, The Reserve (Sheets Road) and the area in front of the dam. Please keep your dog leashed and within your control at all times for the safety of others and wildlife. Be sure to clean up after your pet!

Alley Park

From US-33 take the exit for OH-664 north. Turn left onto Logan Horns Mill Road. The road comes to a three-way fork – take the right most fork – Rock Stull Road and proceed 0.4 miles. You'll see a small sign and an entrance to a small gravel parking lot on your right.
